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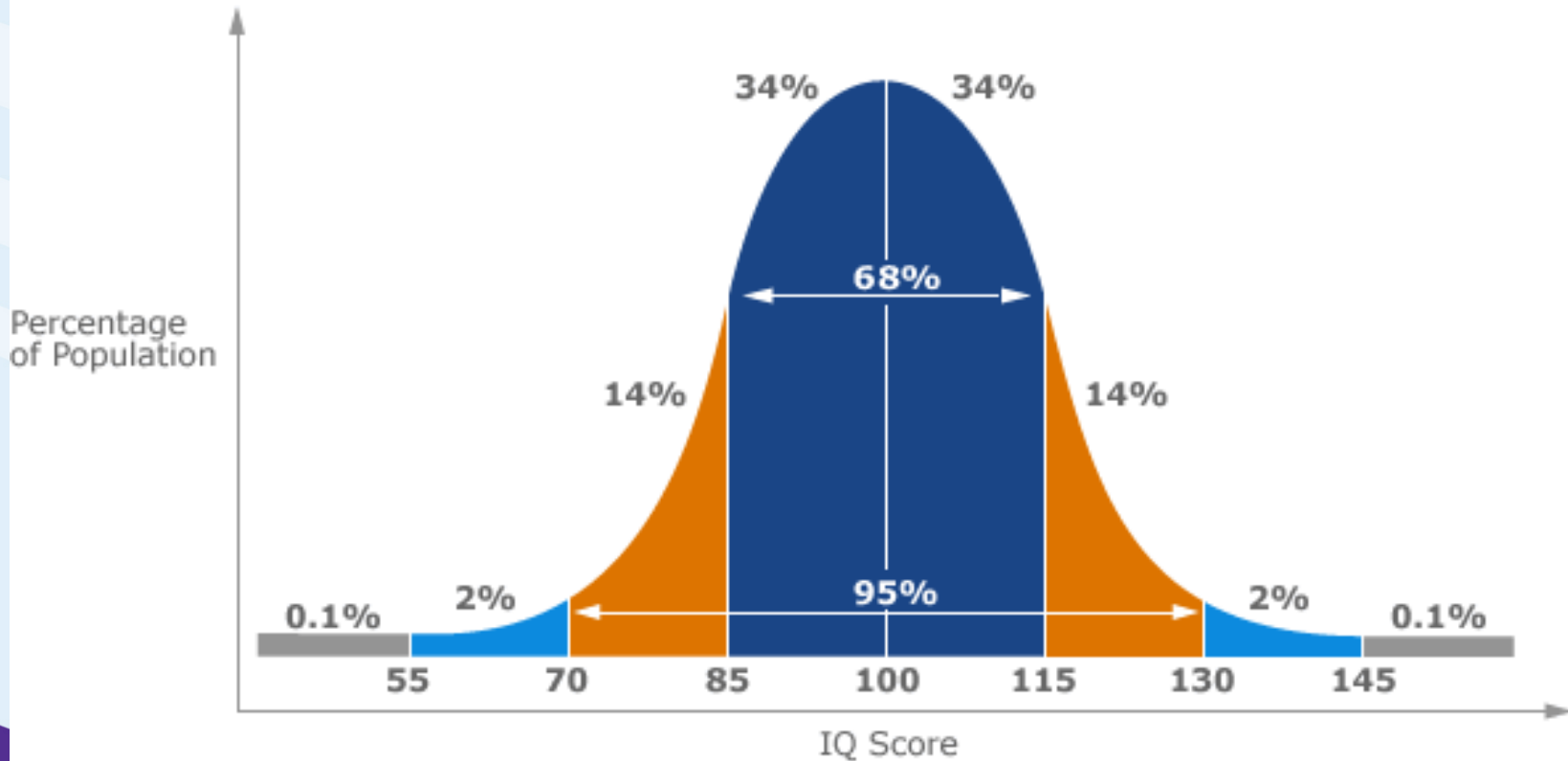
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What is a learning disability?

- a significantly reduced ability to understand new or complex information, to learn new skills (impaired intelligence), and
- a reduced ability to cope independently (impaired social functioning);
- which started before adulthood, with a lasting effect on development

Role of the Community Health Team

- Support and promote the health and well-being of people with learning disabilities living within the community
- Work as a multi professional team
- Provide specialist information, advice and training to service users , carers and other professionals
- Advocating for service users in 'fair access to care'.
