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


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What is a learning disability?

- a significantly reduced ability to understand new or complex information, to learn new skills (impaired intelligence), and
- a reduced ability to cope independently (impaired social functioning);
- which started before adulthood, with a lasting effect on development



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Role of the Community Health Team

Support and promote the health and well-being of people with learning disabilities living within the community

Work as a multi professional team

Provide specialist information, advice and training to service users, carers and other professionals

Advocating for service users in 'fair access to care'.

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Who do we work with?

Adults who have a Learning Disability and...

- Autism and/or Mental Health problems
- Complex Physical Health Needs
- Challenging behaviour
- Forensic needs e.g. 'risky behaviour'.
